ORDINANCE NO 536

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 465 AND 480 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND DECLARING THE INTENT AND ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE IDAHO STATE FIREWORKS LAW AS THE LAWS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR GOVERNING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING THAT THREE COPIES OF THE IDAHO STATE FIREWORKS LAW BE ON FILE AT ALL TIMES IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: It is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to aid and assist by whatever means possible for the utmost consistency in governing and regulating the sale and use of fireworks between the City of Rexburg, Idaho, and the State of Idaho. Toward that end adoption of the Idaho State fireworks law is a necessary means of assuring maximum uniformity within the State.

SECTION II: There is hereby adopted for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the sale and use of fireworks within the City of Rexburg, Idaho, that certain code identified as the Idaho State Fireworks Law, more particularly Title 39, Chapter 26, Idaho Code, and as the same may hereafter be revised by the Idaho Legislature or amended by the City Council of the City of Rexburg, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as an Ordinance of the City of Rexburg as fully as though set forth at length herein.

SECTION III: Three copies of the Idaho State Fireworks Law, together with any revisions or amendments, duly certified by the City Clerk, shall be kept on file in her office for use and examination of and by the public.

SECTION IV: Ordinances No. 465 and 480 of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, and all other ordinances in conflict herewith as of the effective date and time of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION V: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect June 8, 12:01 A.M.
