



ORDINANCE NO. 630

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING ALL THAT PORTION OF THIRD NORTH STREET BETWEEN LOT 1 OF BLOCK 6, AND LOT 1 OF BLOCK 13, IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND ALL THAT PORTION OF FIRST WEST STREET BETWEEN LOT 1, BLOCK 6, AND LOT 2, BLOCK 5, OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS-OF-WAY EASEMENTS AND FRANCHISE RIGHTS OF ANY LOT OWNER, PUBLIC UTILITY OR CITY OF REXBURG; PROVIDING THAT ALL OF SAID STREETS REVERT TO THE OWNER OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE IN LOT 1, BLOCK 6 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG; PROVIDING WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That it is deemed expedient for the public good that the following described platted street of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to-wit:

That portion of Third North Street between Lot 1 of Block 6, and Lot 1 of Block 13; and that portion of First West Street between Lot 1 of Block 6, and Lot 2 of Block 5.

be, and the same is hereby vacated, closed and discontinued and the City Council deems it in the best interests of the adjoining properties that the entire streets so vacated and closed revert to the owner of the adjacent real estate in Lot 1, Block 6 of the City of Rexburg. However, the rights of way, easements and franchise rights of any lot owner, City of Rexburg, or public utility shall not be impaired thereby and the City reserves rights of way and easements under, over and across said vacated premises for City utilities and other City purposes. The Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to said owner in the name of the City of Rexburg, a Quit Claim Deed to the portion of said streets so vacated and closed to the adjacent property owner in Lot 1, Block 6 of the City of Rexburg.

SECTION II: That said street so vacated is not necessary for the use of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, and is not required for any city purposes other than possible future rights of way or easements for City utilities or other City purposes.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and due publication as provided by law.
