**SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 829
OF THE CITY
OF REXBURG, IDAHO**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Rexburg, Idaho, adopted at its regular meeting of September 6, 2000, that Ordinance No. 829 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION II OF ORDINANCE NO. 783 AND ADOPTING THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, COPYRIGHTED BY THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PLUMBING AND MECHANICAL OFFICIALS, 1997 EDITION FOR THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO; REQUIRING COPIES OF SAID CODE TO BE KEPT IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY AND THE PAYMENT OF FEES ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

The effective date of the Ordinance is the date of its passage, approval and publication. A copy of the full text of the Ordinance is available at City Hall, 12 North Center, Rexburg, Idaho. Examination or copies may be requested in writing or in person during regular business hours of the City Clerk, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. pursuant to the Open Records Act, Idaho Code, Title 9, Chapter 3.
