## **Resolution September 26, 1919**

WHEREAS, heretofore and to-wit: the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September, A.D. 1919, Ordinance No. 232 was passed and approved, the same being an ordinance of intention to create a local Sewerage Improvement District in the city of Rexburg, Idaho, for the construction of a sewerage system therein; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 232 was duly published as provided by law, in two consecutive issues of the Rexburg Journal, the official newspaper of said city, published and of general circulation therein, before the time fixed in said ordinance for the filing of protests against said proposed improvements by the owners of land and lots abutting on said proposed improvement district, and included in said assessment district, and

WHEREAS, original publishers affidavit, of publication of said Ordinance No. 232, aforesaid, has been filed with the city clerk, the first publication being on Friday, to -wit: the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September, A.D. 1919, and more than five days prior to the time fixed in said ordinance for the hearing of any such protests; and

WHEREAS, protests against the creation of said Local Improvement District and proposed improvements to be made therein have been filed within the time provided by said ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO: that protests be not allowed and that the mayor and city council proceed with the work of establishing and creating a local sewerage improvement district to be called "Local Sewerage Improvement District No. 1", in the city of Rexburg, Idaho, and the construction of the sewerage system, as provided in Ordinance No. 232, passed and approved September 9<sup>th</sup>, A.D. 1919, and that at the next regular meeting of the mayor and council to be held the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, A.D. 1919 an ordinance creating said sewerage district shall be considered.
