Resolution 03-30-1921

A resolution providing for the appointment of officials and registrars for the annual election of the City of Rexburg to be held April 26th, 1921.

WHEREAS, Statutes of the State of Idaho provide that the City of Rexburg shall hold a biennial election on April 26th, 1921 for the election of municipal officials for the ensuing two years, and

WHEREAS, said statutes provide that the Mayor and City Council may appoint deputy registrars to assist the City Clerk in the registration of all voters in the said City of Rexburg, and

WHEREAS, said statutes provide that election judges shall be appointed and polling places fixed in each precinct.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG

Section 1. That A.J. Hansen be appointed as deputy registrar for the entire City to assist the said Clerk of said City.

Section 2. That the deputy registrar be allowed a compensation of 10¢ per name for each voter registered.

Section 3. That the polling places for the different wards of said City be fixed as follows:

- 1st ward – City Hall
- 2nd ward – Washington School
- 3rd ward – Carlson Store Apartment, College Ave.

Section 4. That the following judges be appointed as the judges of said election:

- 1st ward – G.H.B. Harris, M.P. Evans and Fred Smith.
- 2nd ward – Olaf Anderson, Mrs. Sarah Parkinson and John E. Wilcox,
- 3rd ward – Wm M. Webster, G.N. Atkinson and Mrs. Martha Heath.

The motion was seconded by Charles Zollinger.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll and upon roll call Councilman R.G. Archibald, Charles Zollinger, E.L. Walker and D.W. Stowell voted "Yes".

Councilman G.G. Espe and James R. Wright absent and not voting

Motion by E.L. Walker, seconded by R.G. Archibald, that the meeting adjourn.

Motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
