Resolution 03-05-1924

It having been made to appear to the satisfaction of the Mayor and City Council, by Petition on file, that a large number of colonies of bees are maintained within the City Limits, on the Hinckley Lot, at the corner of Second South and Third West Streets, and in close proximity to the dwellings of a number of citizens; that said bees are a source of constant annoyance and danger to the whole neighborhood, and interfere with the free use and enjoyment of property by the citizens in the vicinity,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council, that the maintenance of said bees within the City Limits be and the same is hereby declared a public nuisance, and the Chief of Police is directed to see that said bees are removed.
