Resolution 07-07-1926

Resolution granting permission to close said street as requested, under the conditions as stated, was introduced and read by Peter Taylor who moved the adoption of said Resolution. The motion on the adoption of the resolution was seconded by H. E. Poole and carried

The Resolution was ordered filed.

After a discussion, Oswald Christensen introduced a Resolution granting permission to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company to cut off the Northwest corner of Lot Two, Block Thirty-one, City of Rexburg, and to grade same for the purpose of diverting the traffic around said corner through the corner of said Lot, thus avoiding the crossing and re-crossing of railroad tracks; said new street to be graded on a level with other streets, said grading and leveling, culvert requirements etc. to be done by the Railroad Company.

Councilman Christensen read and moved the adoption of the said Resolution.

Councilman Hugh A. Wright seconded the motion on the adoption of the Resolution, and the motion carried.
