Resolution 05-09-1928

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE APPOINTMENT OF A WATER COMMISSIONER IN THE CITY OF REXBURG AND REGULATING THE DISPOSITION AND DELIVERY OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES WITHIN THE CITY OF REXBURG, AND TO WATER OUTSIDE THE CITY WHO RECEIVE WATER THROUGH THE CITY CANAL.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg:

1. That the Mayor of the City of Rexburg, be, and he is hereby directed to appoint a Water Commissioner for the said city pursuant to the provisions of Section 3988 of the Idaho Compiled Statutes, said water commissioner to do and perform the duties and services in said section provided.
2. That there shall be distributed and delivered to each water user who demands and is entitled to the distribution and delivery of water to lands outside the City limits five (5) Miner's inches, or one-tenth (1/10) second foot, of flow, for each share of water right and there shall be, and is hereby charged and levied, and shall be collected from each said water user \$4 for each share of water so delivered and distributed to him during the season of 1928.
3. That the distribution and delivery of water for irrigation purposes within the City of Rexburg shall be made by the said water commissioner and there shall be charged and collected from each water user \$5.00 for each share of water and water right, and that one share shall entitle the user to the use of water for irrigation purposes for seven (7) hours' time, once each week, and that the time when each water user may so use the water shall be fixed and regulated by said water commissioner pursuant to the provisions of section 3988, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

Adopted and approved this 9th day of May, A.D., 1928.
