Resolution 07-20-1928

WHEREAS, the commissioner of Public Works or the state of Idaho has made a proposal to the City of Rexburg to procure Federal Aid in the construction of the Yellowstone Park Highway through the City of Rexburg:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Rexburg appropriate for the purpose of aiding in procuring a right-of-way and for the construction of said highway through the city, the sum of THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) and that said item be included in the annual appropriation bill of the City; said sum to be available when the commissioner of Public Works shall enter into a contract with the City to contract with the City to construct said highway through that portion of the City entitled to Federal Aid, as shown by letter of said Commissioner dated July 6, 1928 and estimate enclosed therewith.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor be authorized to enter into a contract with said commissioner to carry out the provisions of this resolution.

The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Mr. Wheelwright. The Mayor stated the question on the adoption of the resolution and roll call showed the following vote.

Those voting Aye: Erdman, Kelley, Poole and Wheelwright.

Whereupon the resolution was declared adopted.
