Resolution 06-05-1929

RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG TO LEVY A TAX FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 1929 IN EXCESS OF THE BILLS ON THE DOLLAR, AND GRANTING PUBLIC HEARING IN RESPECT THERETO.

WHEREAS, it appears that a tax of ten mills on the dollar of taxable property within the City of Rexburg is inadequate to provide the revenues required for the general expenses of the City Government for the fiscal year of 1929 and sinking fund for the redemption of outstanding bonds, and that a levy of fifteen mills on the dollar will be necessary for said purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is provided by Section 3940, Idaho Compiled Statutes, as amended by Chapter 158, Session Laws, 1927, that no levy shall be made in excess of ten mills on the dollar unless the City Council shall grant a public hearing before the appropriation bill for the current year shall be passed, and that notice of such public hearing shall be given by at least two publications in a newspaper published in the City.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg, that the intention is hereby declared to make a levy in excess of ten mills on the dollar, namely fifteen mills on the dollar, in the next ensuing annual appropriation bill authorized by Section 4055, Idaho Compiled Statutes, and that a public hearing be and the same is hereby granted before the council has its regular meeting at the City Hall at 8:00 P.M. on the 19th day of June, 1929, at which time and place any tax payer of said City may appear and be heard regarding said proposed increase in the general tax levy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said public hearing be given by publication in two regular issues of the Rexburg Standard before the date of said hearing, under the title, "Notice to Tax Payers of the City of Rexburg".
