Resolution 11-20-1929

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO CREATE A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT SEWER NUMBER 3 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG: DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO MAKE THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT: STATING THE NAMES OF STREET AND PARTS OF STREET ALONG WHICH, AND THE POINTS BETWEEN WHICH, SAID IMPROVEMENT IS TO BE MADE: THE KIND AND CHARACTER OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT, AND THAT SAME IS AN ORIGINAL IMPROVEMENT: THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF SAME AND THAT THE COST AND EXPENSES THEREOF, ARE TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE ABUTTING, ADJOINING AND ADJACENT LOTS AND LANDS ON THE STREETS ALONG WHICH SUCH IMPROVEMENT IS TO BE MADE, AND UPON LOTS AND LANDS BENEFITED BY SAID IMPROVEMENT AND INCLUDED IN THE DISTRICT: FIXING THE TIME IN WHICH PROTESTS AGAINST SAID PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT OR THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT MAY BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK AND FIXING A TIME WHEN SUCH PROTEST SHALL BE HEARD AND CONSIDERED BY THE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by more than sixty percent of the resident owners of property subject to assessment within the district hereinafter defined, has been filed in the office of the clerk of the city of Rexburg, Idaho, requesting the creation of a local improvement district to make the improvement hereinafter described, and the same having been duly considered by the Mayor and Council of said city:

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

Section 1. That it is the intention, and is hereby declared to be the intention, of the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to create and establish, within the said city, a local improvement district, to be called Local Improvement Sewer District Number Three, of the City of Rexburg, for the construction of a sewer therein; and that it is the intention and is hereby declared to be the intention of said council to make the said proposed improvement.

Section 2. That the streets and parts of streets along which, and the points between which, said improvements to be made are the following, namely: The Southside of 1st North Street between the East Line of 2nd west street, and a point 28 rods East therefrom; The East side of 2nd west street between the South Line of 1st North Street and a point 20 rods South therefrom; and that said district shall include the following described lots and parts of lots and lands, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of lot 2 of Block 31 of the Rexburg Townsite, City of Rexburg, in the County of Madison, State of Idaho, and running thence South 20 rods, thence East 10 rods, thence North 10 rods, thence East 18 rods, thence North 10 rods, thence west 88 rods, to the point of beginning and embracing a part of Lot 1 and a part of Lot 2 of said Block 31.

Section 3. That the said improvement proposed to be made, is an original improvement, and shall be a sewer line 8 inches in diameter with all necessary "Y's" and man holes, and laid a sufficient depth in the ground, and all necessary parts and appurtenances to serve all dwelling houses and other buildings in the said proposed district, and connection with the main sewer line of the city's system, at and between the following points, namely: Commencing at the said main sewer line 166 ½ feet North and 185 feet East of the southwest corner of Lot 3 of Block 31 of the Rexburg Townsite and extending thence for in a straight line 350 feet.


Section 4. That the estimated cost of said proposed improvement is \$625.00 and that same be assessed and levied upon and against the abutting, adjoining, and adjacent lots and lands on the streets along which said improvement is to be made, and upon lots and lands on the streets along which said improvement is to be made, and upon lots and lands benefited by said improvement and includes in the improvement district so formed, (There being no intersections formed by the junction of streets).

Section 5. That Friday the 3rd day of December, A.D., 1929, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time on or before which protests against said proposed improvement or the creation of said improvement district may be filed in the office of the clerk of said city; and the Wednesday the 4th day of December, A.D., 1929, at 8 o'clock P.M. of that day be and the same is hereby fixed and appointed as the time, and the City Hall in said City as the place, when and where such protests shall be heard and considered by the city council.
