Resolution 08-12-1931

A RESOLUTION FAVORING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE STORAGE RESERVOIR OF THE TETON RIVER FOR THE STORAGE OF THE FLOOD WATERS OF SAID STREAM FOR IRRIGATION AND THE PARTICIPATION THEREIN OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, AND THE ACQUIRING OF THREE THOUSAND ACRE FEET OF THE WATER OF SAID STREAM TO SUPPLEMENT WATER RIGHTS OF WATER USERS UNDER THE CITY CANAL, AS FAR AS THE CITY HAS SO TO DO.

WHEREAS various canal companies and water users who obtain water for irrigation purposes from the Teton River have proposed the construction of a reservoir on said river at a point near the north end of the Teton Valley, for the storage of the flood waters of said stream to supplement existing water rights of such companies and water users; and,

WHEREAS the water heretofore appropriated by and decreed to the City of Rexburg is not sufficient for the irrigation of all the lands of water users depending upon such water rights both in and outside the city limits, and that it will be to the best interest of the inhabitants of the city and to the water users under the city canal that additional water rights be acquired by purchase or otherwise, and that storage water in said proposed reservoir will be the only available water rights for such users and it is estimated that 3000 acre feet of such storage water will be required for said purposes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG.

FIRST. --- That the City of Rexburg favors the appropriation of the flood waters of the Teton River for storage purposes to supplement water rights of water users from said river and the construction of a reservoir suitable and of sufficient capacity for the storage of such flood water.

SECOND. --- That the Mayor and Council of said City of Rexburg favor the purchase and acquisition of rights in any reservoir that may be constructed on the Teton River for the purposes herein referred to, sufficient to secure to the water users in said City and outside the limits of said city depending upon the canal of said city for the irrigation of their said lands, and not exceeding 3000 acre feet.



THIRD. --- That the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg favor the appropriation of such sums of money from the funds of said city as may be available and lawfully appropriated for such purposes to pay and defray the pro rate portion of the costs and expenses of the necessary

preliminary investigations and surveys and obtaining permits for the appropriation and storage of said waters, on the basis of said city acquiring in any such reservoir 3000 acre feet of storage water.

FOURTH. --- That the Mayor of the City of Rexburg be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to make all proper and necessary application to the proper committees or officers as the case may be, to secure for the benefit of water users under said city canal 3000 acre feet of storage water in any reservoir that may be constructed on the Teton River.
