Resolution 03-15-1933

RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ACTING CITY CLERK.

WHEREAS, JAMES BLAKE, City Clerk of the City of Rexburg, is confined in a hospital and is not able to do or perform any of the duties of his said office, and there is no assistant or deputy in said office and nonprovided for, and it is necessary in the interest of the city that some competent person be appointed to act as and in the capacity of City Clerk during the disability of said James Blake, and it appears that Raymond Hill is such a person and that he is now in the employ of the city:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT Raymond Hill be and he is hereby appointed acting City Clerk of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, with power and authority to do and perform all the acts and duties of the office of City Clerk of said city during the time of the disability of said James Blake, or until the next general city election, in said city.
