



Resolution 09-19-1934

WHEREAS, The City of Rexburg has under consideration the execution of a Supplemental agreement modifying that certain Street lighting contract with the Utah Power and Light Company, dated December 18th, 1929, which will temporarily reduce the number and size of lamps provided for in said contract, thereby permitting a saving to the city in the cost of operating its street lighting system during the term provided for in the said supplemental agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed in his official capacity to execute; and the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest, countersign, and affix the corporate seal the said supplemental agreement, and said contract and supplementary agreement continues in effect until Sept. 15th, 1934. The proposal dated Sept. 15th, 1933 and accepted by the Utah Power and Light Co. on Sept. 27th, 1933, are hereby confirmed and approved. The motion was seconded by Councilman Stowell and the roll call showed the following vote.

Absent and not voting: Councilman H.A. Wright


Mayor Porter reported meeting the committee on the proposed change of the city canal channel, stating that he informed the said committee that the city would refuse to be a party to the proposed change.
