Resolution 10-10-1934

RESOLUTION DECLARING A CERTAIN BUILDING TO BE A NUISANCE.

WHEREAS it appears to the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg that the certain building, namely the wood and sheet iron building located on the north-west corner of lot (3) of block (34) of the Rexburg Town site, on what is known as the C.W. and M. property, is so dilapidated and in such a condition as to menace public health and the safety of persons and other property on account of increased fire hazard and the accumulation of rubbish therein resulting from it not being occupied for any useful purpose and long neglected and being a place where boys and idle men loiter about.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of Rexburg that the certain wood and sheet iron building located on the corner of lot (3) of block (34) of the Rexburg town site be and the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance for the reason and on the ground above stated, and that it be and is hereby ordered that the said building be removed from said premises to some point outside the Fire limits of the City of Rexburg, or destroyed.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER that the Consolidated Wagon and Machine Co. be served with a copy of this resolution, by the chief of Police of the City, together with notice to remove said building within thirty days from date of such service, and if said building is not removed within said time, in that event the same shall be removed by the City under direction of the Chief of Police at the expense of the Consolidated Wagon and Machine Co. the owner of said Property.
