## **Resolution 03-19-1941**

A Resolution calling for a city election in and for the city of Rexburg to be held on April 22, 1941, and directing that notices be published in the local papers and posted in the various precincts; providing for registers and judges of election was introduced by Attorney G.W. Poole. Councilman Miller moved that the same be adopted. Seconded by Hopkins and unanimously approved. The following polling places for election were designated,

2 <sup>nd</sup> Precinct	Washington School Building
3 <sup>rd</sup> Precinct	#25 College Avenue
