Resolution 12-18-1957

WHEREAS, THE City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, has leased to the Rexburg Golf Association certain property at the Municipal Airport for the purpose of constructing and maintain a golf course, and the term of said lease has expired, and

WHEREAS, said golf course has been constructed and maintained by said association at great expense and is a valuable contribution as a recreational facility to the inhabitants of the City of Rexburg as well as the entire valley, and

WHEREAS, such property is not needed for municipal purposes and should be set apart as a golf links as provided by Section 50-1008, Idaho Code, and

WHEREAS, the cost of operating and maintaining said golf course by the City of Rexburg would be prohibitive at the present time, and the City Council deems it not advisable for the city to operate said golf links, and

WHEREAS, the Rexburg Golf Association has applied to the Mayor and City Council for a lease of the same for a term of twenty years at the annual rental of \$1.00 a year, with option to extend for an additional twenty years.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council that the portion of the Municipal Airport property now being used as a golf links be and the same is hereby set apart to be used as a golf links, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Rexburg enter into the proper contracts with the Rexburg Golf Association necessary and proper to carry out the purposes of Section 50-1008, Idaho Code and that the City lease to the Rexburg Golf Association for a term of twenty years, at the annual rental of \$1.00 a year, with the option to extend for an additional twenty years. That ground at the municipal airport upon which said golf course is now constructed, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to enter into such a lease with the Rexburg Golf Association.
