Resolution 01-21-1959

NOTICE OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 5 FOR CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF SEWER LATERALS IN REXBURG, IDAHO, AND HEARING PROTESTS AGAINST SAID PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT OR THE CREATION OF SUCH DISTRICT.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, held on the 21st day of January, 1959, the City Council passed and the Mayor of said City approved Amended Resolution No.1, being a Resolution of Intention of the Mayor and City Council to make certain improvements, the general character of said improvements being described as follows:

Construction and installation of sanitary sewer laterals, complete with manholes and all other necessary appurtenances and restoration of street surface wherever necessitated by reason of the construction and installation of said sanitary sewer laterals.

The costs and expenses of such improvements shall be assessed upon the abutting, adjoining, contiguous and adjacent lots and lands and upon lots and lands benefited and included in the improvement district formed, each lot and parcel of land being separately assessed for the debt thereof in proportion to the number of square feet of such lands and lots abutting, adjoining, contiguous and adjacent thereto or included in the improvement district to the distance back from such street if platted in blocks to the center of the block, if platted in lots to the center of the lots, and if not platted to the distance of one hundred twenty-five feet, and in proportion to the benefits derived to such property by said improvements, sufficient to cover the total cost and expense of the work to the center of the street. The costs and expenses of all intersections shall be borne by, apportioned to and assessed against the property within said district in proportion to the benefits derived from such improvement.

That said Amended Resolution No. 1 is now on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City where any interested party may inspect the same and to which Amended Resolution No. 1 reference is hereby made for further information in regard thereto. The estimated total cost of the proposed improvement is \$87,000.00.

That said proposed improvement district shall consist of the property within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at a point 100 feet South of the Northeast corner of Lot 2, of Block 41 of the Original Rexburg Town site, in the City of Rexburg, as per the recorded plat thereof, and running thence South 2837 feet to the Southeast corner, Lot 6, of Block 9 of the Parker Addition

to the City of Rexburg: thence West 2,227.5 feet to a point 330 feet West of the East Line of Section 25, Township 6 North, Range 39 E.B.M., which point is on the West boundary line of Rexburg Town site; thence North 3003 feet; to the Center of West Main Street; thence East 379.5 feet, thence South 166 feet; thence East 1843 feet to the point of beginning.

Also commencing at a point 100 feet North of the Southeast corner of Lot 4 of Block 28 of the aforesaid Original Rexburg Town site; thence running North 1319 feet; to the Northeast corner of Block 27 of said Town site, thence West 330 feet; thence North 429 feet; thence West 709.5 feet, to the west boundary line of said Town site as above described; thence South 1914 feet; to the Center of West Main Street; thence East 379.5 feet; thence North 166 feet; thence East 660 feet to the point of beginning.

Said sanitary sewer laterals to be constructed on the following streets between the following points:

South Third West between First and Fourth South Streets
South Fifth West between Main Street and Fourth South
North Fifth West between Main Street and Second North

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that up to and including 7:30 o'clock p.m. on the 11th day of February, 1959, written protests against the establishment of said improvement district or the construction of said sewer laterals may be filed with the City Clerk by any property owner or owners, at which time at the City Hall the Mayor and City Council will hear and consider all written protests filed as aforesaid.
