Resolution 11-01-1961

WHEREAS, the Ricks College expansion program, as shown to the City Council by Leland M. Perry, calls for the cooperation of the City of Rexburg, in helping with such expansion program, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Rexburg, to cooperate in every way possible with Ricks College in its growth and development, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it will be necessary for said college to run steam lines, water lines, sewer lines, signaling and video lines, electric lines, underground and overhead, all such lines to be along, across, under and over the city streets and sidewalks within the Ricks College campus from Second South to and beyond Fourth South and from First West to Second East.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City of Rexburg will cooperate in every possible way, within its ability to do so, with the Ricks College growth and development program;

That the said college is hereby granted permission to install steam lines, water lines, sewer lines, signaling and video liens, electric lines, underground and overhead, all such lines to be installed across, along, over and under city streets and sidewalks within the Ricks College campus from Second South beyond Fourth South and from First West to Second East;

That the said Ricks College is hereby granted all necessary rights-of-way and easements along, across, over and under the city streets and sidewalks for the installation and construction of such lines is aforesaid.
