Resolution 06-17-1964

WHEREAS, bills have been submitted to the United States Senate and the United States House of Representatives for the construction of the Lower Teton Reclamation Project, including the Fremont Dam and Reservoir, and

WHEREAS, the same has been set for House Committee hearings in Washington, D.C. and

WHEREAS, the disastrous floods this area has experienced in prior years and the drought conditions which have prevailed in prior years, resulted in this area being declared a flood disaster areas as well as a drought area in the same year, which clearly demonstrates the vital importance and urgency of this project for flood control and supplemental water purposes.

AND WHEREAS, there has never been any opposition to said project at any hearing pertaining to the same, and at all hearings it has been unanimously endorsed and approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That said House Committee recommend the immediate passage of said bills authorizing the construction of said Fremont Dam and Reservoir.

Glenn Peterson moved the resolution be approve by the Council, Gordon Smith seconded and passed unanimously.

Claims in the amount of \$8,426.05 were presented by Laurn Ashliman who moved same be granted and paid. The motion was seconded by Glenn Peterson and Passed unanimously.
