Resolution 06-01-1966

The following Resolution was offered by Councilman David Withers, and seconded by Councilman John C. Porter:

“Whereas, the City of Rexburg has fulfilled all of its contract obligations as provided by Section 18-H-3 Ordinance No.

There is now a surplus in the water and sewer fund in the amount of \$90,700.33, which should be transferred to the General Fund and

Whereas; it appears there will be a net surplus in the water and sewer fund each year after all contract obligations have been fulfilled as set forth in said section 18-H-3 Ordinance No.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the surplus in the water and sewer fund in the amount of \$90,700.33 be transferred to the General Fund, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer said amount to the General Fund.

Be it further resolved that the net amount remaining in the water and sewer fund each year hereafter, upon the performance of all contract obligations as required by Section 18-H-3 Ordinance No. be transferred to the General Fund, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to make such transfer each year.”
