Resolution 08-02-1967

Resolution No. 1 was introduced by Councilman Peterson to establish an L.I.D. No. 17; this was seconded by Councilman Porter.

“NOTICE OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH REXBURG LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 17 AND HEARING OF PROTESTS. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL HELD ON AUGUST 2, 1967, A RESOLUTION WAS PASSED DECLARING THE INTENTION OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO CREATE A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE WORKS IMPROVEMENTS, SAID IMPROVEMENTS STREETS, ALLEYS, LOTS PIECES AND PARCELS OF LAND.”
