Resolution 06-18-1969

RESOLUTION:

WHEREAS, A.W. MILLER has been given a permit to construct an apartment house on property belonging to him in the city of Rexburg, Idaho, and which is adjacent to property owned by Frank H. Jacobs, and

WHEREAS, THERE appears to be some questions as to whether or not the apartment house being constructed is less than the footage requirement between property lines, and

WHEREAS, FRANK H. JACOBS, the adjoining property owner who would be affected in the event said apartment house is less than the five foot distance requirement between buildings and property line, having waived his right to protest thereto, NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the five foot distance between the building being constructed by A.W. Miller and the adjoining property belonging to Frank H. Jacobs, be, and the same is hereby waived and A.W. Miller is given permission to proceed with the construction of said apartment house as the same is now located on his property.
