Resolution 04-21-1971

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of June, 1970, the City of Rexburg, Idaho, passed Ordinance No. 507, granting to Don Ellis, his heirs and assigns, the right and privilege to construct, erect, operate and maintain over and under the streets, alleys and public ways of the City, poles, towers, wires, cables and underground conduits, and to conduct and operate a community antenna television system in the City of Rexburg, Idaho, and providing the terms, conditions and regulations thereof, and

WHEREAS, the said Don Ellis is desirous of assigning said Franchise to a corporation known as Rex TV, formed by the said Don Ellis for the purpose of constructing and operating the cable television plant and system in Rexburg, Idaho, as provided by the terms of said franchise, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the said Don Ellis did commence construction within the meaning of the time limit provision of Section XVII of Ordinance 507, and

WHEREAS, it appears that it would be favorable to the City of Rexburg, Idaho, as well as Don Ellis that said franchise be assigned to Rex TV, Inc., an Idaho Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, be and they hereby give their consent to the assignment of the cable television franchise granted to Don Ellis by Ordinance No. 507, by the said Don Ellis to Rex TV, Inc., an Idaho Corporation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Henry M. Shirley, Mayor of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, be, and he is hereby designated as the official member of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to sign the consent for assignment of said franchise by Don Ellis to Rex TV. Inc., an Idaho Corporation.
