Resolution 02-06-1974

RESOLUTION ON EMERGENCY DECLARED FOR SNOW REMOVAL EQUIPMENT

The following resolution was introduced by Warren Porter who moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City of Rexburg does not have adequate equipment for snow removal; that winter storms are so severe the streets become impassable resulting in cessation of City services and the use of emergency vehicles; that an emergency exists and the public interest and necessity require the purchase of snow removal equipment without compliance with Section 50-341 Idaho Code.

Be it Further Resolved:

That the Mayor and City Council be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to forthwith make the purchase of such necessary snow removal equipment, without compliance with Section 50-341, Idaho Code.
