Resolution 1979(3)

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States provided an adjustment program for the Teton Disaster Area, and

WHEREAS, among other projects designated as needed by the different communities, the Congress of the United States provided that the City of Rexburg, County of Madison, State of Idaho, be allocated the following economic adjustment measures:

Storm Drains	Will provide adequate Drainage and waste water Management which is Seriously needed due to Flood victim relocation	\$1,720,000	\$1,720,000
Water Supply	Due to relocation of flood Victims the recently installed Water storage and distribution System has already become Obsolete and in need of Expansion.	\$1,090,000	\$1,090,000
Sewer Main Extension	Due to flood victim relocation from the plain to Rexburg Bench area, there is now a need To extend sewer services	\$210,000	\$210,000
Street Improvements	Flood victim relocation requires access roads into areas being settled out of the flood on the Rexburg bench.	\$527,000	\$527,000
Parking Facilities	This redevelopment measure Will assure the competitive Position of Central Business District merchants whose Livelihood is threatened by Proposed "mall-type" Developments outside the CBD.	\$600,000	\$450,000

AND, WHEREAS, at the time this program was authorized in June, 1977, the need for said projects existed, and

WHEREAS, the conditions have not changed and the need for such projects still exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Rexburg, County of Madison, State of Idaho, is in need of the economic adjustment measures above designated; and as soon as the funds are made available, the City of Rexburg will immediately commence to utilize such funds for the installation and construction of each of said measures above designated.
