Resolution 07-09-1990

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 28, 1990, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES, DESIGNATING THE REGISTRAR AND DEPUTY REGISTRARS, AND ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Special city election will be held in and for the City of Rexburg, on the 28th day of August, at which time the electorate will vote on an override election in the amount of \$541,500 over a period of five years for the Fire Department equipment replacement and maintenance, the addition of three full time professional fire fighters, basic hazardous materials training, and an upgrade of the volunteer fire fighter program.

SECTION 2. The following are designated as the polling places for such election:

FOR THE FIRST PRECINCT: Adams School-110 North 2nd East

FOR THE SECOND PRECINCT: Madison County Library-73 North Center

FOR THE THIRD PRECINCT: Kennedy School- 60 South 5th West

FOR THE FOURTH PRECINCT: Lincoln School-358 East 2nd South

SECTION 3. That Rose Bagley, City Clerk, is hereby designated as Registrar and the following as Deputy Registrars: Nancy Ottensen, Deputy City Clerk; First Precinct, Annette Poulsen; Second Precinct, Marie Hathaway; Third Precinct, Marion Van Houten; Fourth Precinct, Jo Ann Ball.

SECTION 4. The Clerk, for and on behalf of the Mayor and Council, shall give public notice of the time and place of holding such general city election by posting such notice in three public places or publishing such notice in at least two issues of the Standard Journal, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Rexburg, Idaho, the first publication of such notice to be made not less than 45 days previous to the date of such city election and the last publication not less than 15 days prior to the election; the notice so published shall state the places of registration and the name of the Registrar and the Deputy Registrars, and the requirements for registration of electors at such city and such other information as may be necessary to give full facts of such election and registration; said notice to contain such information in accordance with the requirements of Section 50-436 of the Idaho Code.
