**"A Resolution to Submit an Application for an Idaho Community Development Block Grant to Assist in the Construction and Reconstruction of 7th South Street"**

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to develop 7th South Street to provide a new major access road into the southern area of the city in the east-west direction to make up for the closure of Viking Drive (4th South); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to alleviate a serious traffic condition due to increased traffic in the area of Madison Middle School, the recently constructed large secondary school at the intersection of South Yellowstone Highway and 7th South; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to create a primary arterial road to connect the south portion of the City of Rexburg to US 20; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to submit an Idaho Community Development Block Grant Application to the Idaho Department of Commerce for a Public Facility Grant to assist in the construction and reconstruction of 7th South Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The City Council of the City of Rexburg hereby authorizes the submission of the Idaho Community Development Block Grant Application to the Idaho Department of Commerce for funds to assist in the construction of the 7th South Street Project. The City Council also authorizes Nile L. Boyle, Mayor of Rexburg, to sign and execute the Application and associated documents.
