RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF REXBURG COMPREHENSIVE PLAN: 2010

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of January, 2001, the City Council for the City of Rexburg was duly convened upon notice properly given and a quorum was duly noted:

WHEREAS, the appropriate public hearings had been held before the Planning & Zoning Commission and the City Council with regards to amendments to the City of Rexburg Comprehensive Plan: 2010, dated July, 1998, listed as follows:

1. Rexburg Business Park - The easterly portion being for industrial use and the westerly portion being Highway Business District or commercial.
2. Salem Highway and south Cemetery Road - This area to be change to Highway Business District.
3. Area south of Teton River near Barney Dairy Road - Previously shown as open space, the front portion be changed to commercial and the area further to the east was changed to reflect single family residential.
4. Area east of U. S. 20 between 1500 West and U. S. 20 changed to multi-family residential (MDR).
5. Quarter of block from Main Street on 1st West changed to High Density Residential (HDR).
6. Two blocks on So. 2nd West have been built as High Density Residential (HDR) recommended change to comply with the Comprehensive Plan.
7. Approximately 80 acres north of 7th South west of old Hwy 191, changed to allow single family residential on the northwest corner, an area through the center for multi-family housing and the area along the railroad be commercial.

NOW THEREFORE, by resolution duly adopted on the date first above written, be it resolved by the Mayor and the City Council the following:

- The City of Rexburg does accept and hereby adopts the recommendations for amendments to the Comprehensive Plan 2010, dated July, 1998, as stated above
